AHEPA Constantine and Carol Cassis H.S. Senior Scholarship (and Trade School Scholarship)

- a. (Grand) father must be in good standing with the Constantine Cassis Chapter #170 for at least two years or applicant's (Grand) mother must be in good standing with the Daughters of Penelope, Pasithea Chapter #141 for at least two years or you are a member of either Lord Byron Chapter #223 of the Sons of Pericles or Victory Chapter #76 of the Maids of Athena in good standing for two years.

- b. You must be a **High School Senior**.
- c. Certification from the school registrar acknowledging your full-time status
- d. Submit SAT (administered by the College Entrance Examination Board) or ACT(American College Training Program).
- e. Submit High School transcripts or comparable grades.
- f. SAT/ACT score may be optional for those applying for Trade School Scholarship, but can be substituted with part time work, school sports or club activities, out of school or volunteer activities, etc.

AHEPA Constantine and Carol Cassis College/University Scholarship

- a. (Grand) father must be in good standing with the Constantine Cassis Chapter #170 for at least two years or applicant's (grand) mother must be in good standing with the Daughters of Penelope, Pasithea Chapter #141 for at least two years, or you are a member of either Lord Byron Chapter #223 of the Sons of Pericles in good standing for at least two years (excluding any incentive year) and your dual membership affiliation is with AHEPA Cassis Chapter #170 and no other chapter, or Victory Chapter #76 of the Maids of Athena in good standing for at least two years.
- b. You must be a **full-time student (Freshman-Junior)**.
- c. You must be carrying a minimum of 12 semester hours at an accredited college or university, and should not be higher than Junior year status.
- d. Certification from the school registrar acknowledging your full-time status is required.
- e. Submission of your College transcript.

St. Paul's Scholarship (and Trade School Scholarship)

- a. Either yourself or one of your (grand) parents must be a Steward in good standing at the Cathedral of St. Paul's for at least two years.
- b. **NONE OF THE FOLLOWING CAN APPLY:**
(Grand) father a member of the Constantine Cassis Chapter #170, (grand) mother a member of the Daughters of Penelope, Pasithea Chapter #141, the applicant cannot be a member of either Lord Byron Chapter #223 of the Sons of Pericles or Victory Chapter #76 of the Maids of Athena.

- d. Certification from the school registrar acknowledging your full-time status.
- e. Submit SAT or ACT score.
- f. Submit high school transcript or comparable grades
